ORDER (ORAL)

1. Heard Mr. S. Deb, learned counsel for the petitioners.
2. Also heard Mr. N.D. Chullai, learned AAG on behalf of the State respondent No. 1 and Mr. B. Khyriem, learned counsel for the respondent No. 2.
3. Without going into the merits of this petition, suffice it to say that the petitioners, inter alia, has made a prayer for disposal of a representation dated 02.01.2023 (Annexure-10 of this petition) filed before the Office of

the Commissioner of Transport Department, Government of Meghalaya, Shillong by the petitioners herein for an alleged infringement of their rights, vis-à-vis, the advertisement for the post of Enforcement Inspector which was floated on 26.04.2017.

4. From the submission made by the parties herein, what could be understood is that once the representation aforementioned is disposed of, the parties would know the position of the case, vis-à-vis, their rights or rather infringement of their rights as regard the subject matter indicated above. At this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that irrespective of the said representation dated 02.01.2023 being filed before the concerned authority, the petitioners may be allowed to file a fresh representation before the appropriate authorities for redressal of their grievances.

5. The learned AAG has no objection to this proposition. Accordingly, as observed above, without touching on the merits of this petition, the same is hereby disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to take necessary steps in accordance with law.
